HHA requires equal opportunity in competitive contracting as a matter of Public Policy. HHA is requiring a 25% presumptive objective for MBE/WBE participation for all contracts. Any bidder with less than 15% MBE and 10% WBE may be determined as "irresponsible". Subcontract dollar amounts are included towards the MBE/WBE calculation.
